Victoria's newest Heavy Maintenance Facility!

Metro Train Melbourne's Craigieburn heavy maintenance facility is a new, purpose built facility to service Melbourne's suburban Electric Multiple Units. Located 30 km north of the CBD, covers 10.8 hectares of land and can accommodate 31 trains. It has been specifically developed to cater for all suburban passenger rolling-stock, including Siemens, Comeng, and X'tropolis trains; and is flexibly provisioned for the next generation of trains. The modern facility includes an extensive main workshop building, four elevated tracks, two lifting tracks, wheel profiling machinery, and a train wash.

The tour will depart the Southern Cross Station terminal at 8:00am and return at 12:40pm . Light refreshments will be included.

For Safety, you will be required to wear solid shoes, no open toe, or high heels, long sleeves and long pants (no shorts, no skirts). High visibility vests and safety glasses will be provided by MTM.
