### Experience Victoria's new regional connection to the Melbourne CBD!

Regional Rail Link is Victoria's first regional rail line to service new destinations in over 80 years. The line was commissioned in July 2015 and weaves a tight and intricate path through inner suburban Melbourne, before progressing to more forgiving geometry which enables high speed (160km/h) passenger services to the Melbourne satellite suburbs of Tarneit and Wyndham Vale, before connecting to the Geelong intercity lines.

The tour will begin at Southern Cross Station, with a history of the RRL project and its achievements. You will then travel on a scheduled VLocity passenger service to Wyndham Vale Station, with the ride accompanied by a guided description of the technical aspects of notable infrastructure assets as they are encountered on the Journey.

Following a question and answer session, participants will explore Wyndham Vale Station (Victoria's newest regional station) before returning to Southern Cross Station.
